

# How To Clean Anti Slip Treated Tiled Floors

We are finding GLAZED ceramic tiles in slippery kitchen, high traffic, or high maintenance areas.

Why? This should not be happening and is totally incorrect and inappropriate.

Let's not offend anyone, but it is the wrong specification of tile and one reason we exist.

To those customers that suggest that they like the look or the easy cleaning, they are forgetting it MUST be corrected and is simply a hazardous condition for staff and patrons.

A company in the US has introduced a long-handled, floor DECK BRUSH scrubber, to be used for, **"those harder to clean surfaces"**. It has a weighted 4kgs head that provides weight onto the surface while cleaning. It may seem like a good idea but it is outrageously priced at over \$300.USD per unit and should be unnecessary with a quality cleaner. I would suggest that a good quality (large number of fine bristles) deck brush, coupled with a coupled with a quality cleaner such as the 'Maintenance Solution™' will clean the floor with the effort of a five year old.

A long handled squeegee is a very useful tool to have on the job for cleaning and for water relocation. It will, surprisingly, clean floors much more efficiently than a mop. This is where weight and effort can be appreciated; however, save your money by placing a 2kg weight lifters plate down over the handle. This will provide you with the effort to scrub the surface with less effort on the arm muscles.
